
MAT 2010 Conference – Penguin High School – How To Get There

How to get to Penguin High School:

If you are driving towards the West along the Bass Highway, take the first turn off to Penguin from the Bass Highway, labelled 'Penguin Sports Complex'. Proceed up the road (Dial Road) away from the water until you reach the Golf Course. Turn into the Sports Complex Road and continue along around the back of the stadium until you hit Ironcliffe Road. The school is a little further down Ironcliffe Road, just after the sports stadium. Parking is available at the school (please feel free to use all parking spaces including the bus bays) and also along the footpath in both directions. There is also the option to park near the sports stadium.

If you are driving towards the East along the Bass Highway, take the last turn off to Penguin from the highway labelled 'Penguin Sports Complex'. Then follow the same directions as above.



How to get to the Conference Dinner:

The conference dinner is being held at Casablanca, Penguin Surf Club, Preservation Bay. The food is all provided but you will need to pay for drinks. To get to Casablanca, follow Ironcliffe Road down into Penguin, then turn left into Crescent Street and then at the end into Main Road. Turn right along the Old Bass Highway (The Coast Road) until you reach the near end of Preservation Bay. The Surf Club is a red brick building that is not easily missed.

Please remember the roads in Penguin have a 50 km/h speed limit and that Penguin High School is in a 40 km/h school zone.
